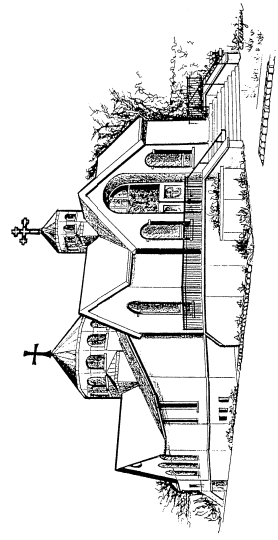

CHURCH ETIQUETTE: Father Diran and the Parish Council sincerely request that parishioners respond to the following, so that our beloved Church may function in a more orderly and respectful manner:

- **Altar Candles** ~ Please note, according to Armenian Church tradition, all Altar Candles must be lit before the beginning of *Badarak*. Those desiring to light candles in memory of loved ones or friends are requested to notify the Church Office in advance by noon of Thursday preceding the Sunday of remembrance.
 - **Reverence Required** ~ Please be advised that, according to the tradition of the Armenian Church, members of the congregation are strongly reminded to refrain from walking in and out of the Sanctuary while services are in progress. You are *especially* reminded **not to do so** during 1) the Chanting of the Gospel, (p. 17); 2) recitation of the Creed (*Havadamk*), (p. 18); 3) the Chalice Procession, (pg. 24-25); 4) the Hymn, “*Der Voghormya*,” (pg. 45); and 5) distribution of the Holy Communion, (p. 49). Also, please do not chew gum or cross legs during church services.
- Please observe the “arrows” in the new liturgy books. They indicate when you should *Stand, Sit, or Kneel*.

Dear Friends,

As some of you know, our mom is suffering from Non-Hodgkin's Peripheral T-Cell Lymphoma, an aggressive and unpredictable form of blood cancer. She has endured over six months of in-patient chemotherapy and a debilitating bone marrow transplant, but somehow the disease has persisted.

At this point, her only chance for a cure is an allogeneic stem cell transplant. In order to perform this procedure, the doctors need a blood donor who is a genetic match, but currently, there are no registered donors who qualify.

Anyone can be that match, and that is why we are writing to you today. Joining the "Be The Match" registry is simple (see below), and requires only a cotton swab to collect some cheek cells from the inside of your mouth. If you are a match, your participation could mean the gift of life to someone - like our mother - who is desperately in need of your help.

- You must be 18 to 60 years old.
- If you are a match, you will be asked to donate peripheral blood (from your arm), just as you would if you were to give blood.
- The recipient of a match, NOT the donor, incurs all costs.

THERE ARE 3 WAYS TO JOIN THE "BE THE MATCH" REGISTRY:

1. ONLINE at www.marlow.org. Click first on "Join the Registry" and then on "Join Now." Complete the online form to order your registration kit, which will be sent to you by mail. Follow the instructions in the kit to collect a sample of cheek cells, and then return the kit in the addressed envelope that is provided for you.
2. IN PERSON at a Recruitment Center. Go to www.marlow.org to find a recruitment center near you.
3. IN PERSON at a BE THE MATCH drive near you. Go to www.marlow.org to find a date and location.
