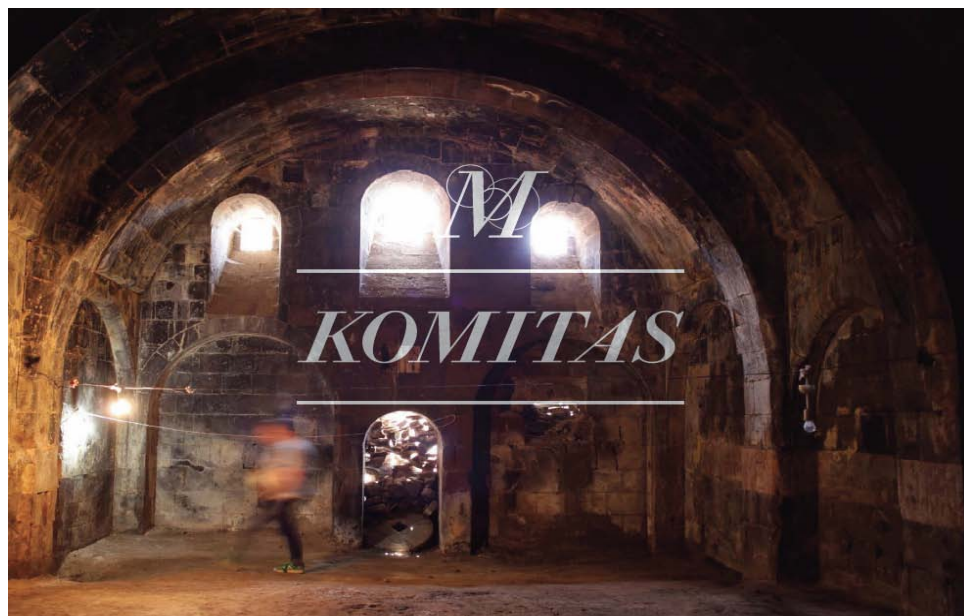


Komitas

A Multimedia Journey



With Live Performance by Musician and Composer **Marc Sinan**

Komitas is a multimedia journey that traces the great composer's ethno-musicological trips through Anatolia, his deportation to Chankiri and the psychological turmoil triggered by the latter.

Komitas combines images and sound of the Armenian homeland, original recording of Komitas and **Marc Sinan's** original composition to recreate the life and times of the beloved vartabed. Marc creates a tapestry of art and beauty that is both life-affirming and tragic.

Marc Sinan lives in Germany. He was born to an Armenian - Turkish mother and a German father. On concert stages since his youth, Marc is a much-admired guitarist and composer.

Komitas has been commissioned by Germany's Irsee Monastery, the European Center for the Arts Dresden, the Maxim Gorki Theater, Anadolu Kultur Istanbul and TAK Theater Lichtenstein. Starting April 24, 2015, it will tour Irsee, Dresden, Berlin and Istanbul.
