
## SCOUT TUFANKJIAN'S There Is Only the Earth: Images from the Armenian Diaspora Project

Although best known for her work documenting the Barack Obama campaigns, Armenian-American photojournalist Scout Tufankjian has spent the bulk of her career working in the Middle East, including four years working in the Gaza Strip and extensive time in Egypt documenting the Egyptian Revolution and its



aftermath. Her book on the 2007-2008 Obama campaign, Yes We Can: Barack Obama's History-Making Presidential Campaign was published in December of 2008 and was a New York Times and LA Times bestseller.

Her new book, There is Only the Earth: Images from the Armenian Diaspora Project, is the culmination of six years spent documenting Armenian communities in over 20 different countries.
