Sarah Derderian, originally from

Philadelphia, repatriated to Armenia 3 years ago. She moved to Gyumri and began working at the **Debi Arach Children's Center** as their Development Officer and Special Project Director. In November 2017, she founded the **Dogs of Gyumri** organization, coordinating the adoption of 40 dogs both in Armenia and abroad in its first year. Future plans include opening the first animal welfare center and shelter in Armenia outside of Yerevan. Although conditions in Gyumri can be challenging, the meaningful work with both children, families, and dogs have inspired Sarah to stay and work in Armenia's second largest city.
