
Turkey and the Armenian Ghost: On the Trail of the Genocide

In *Turkey and the Armenian Ghost*, Laure Marchand and Guillaume Perrier lead a search to historical sites and interview politicians, elderly survivors, descendants, authors and activists in a quest to expose the truth about this unrecognized and unpunished crime.

They journey into remote mountain regions, tiny hamlets, and the homes of traumatized victims of a deadly persecution that continues to this day. They reveal little-known aspects of the history and culture of a people who have been rendered invisible in their ancient homeland.

Marchand and **Perrier** illuminate complex issues of blame and responsibility, guilt and innocence and discuss the roles played by "righteous Turks," the Kurds, the converts, the rebels and the "leftovers of the sword."

Turkey and the Armenian Ghost is translation of the award-winning *La Turquie et le fantôme arménien*. It has also been published in Turkey.

Marchand is a correspondent for French newspapers *Le Figaro* and *Le Nouvel Observateur*. **Perrier** is a correspondent for *Le Monde* and *Le Point*. They live in Istanbul.
