

Ամենայն Հայոց Կաթողիկոսն ընդունեց Ֆրանսիայի Սենատի պատվիրակությանը

Ապրիլի 24-ին Ն.Ս.Օ.Տ.Տ. Գարեգին Երկրորդ Ծայրագույն Պատրիարք և Ամենայն Հայոց Կաթողիկոսը Մայր Աթոռ Սուրբ Էջմիածնում ընդունեց Ֆրանսիայի Սենատում Լեռնային Ղարաբաղի հարցով խմբի հիմնադիր և նախագահ, Արևելքի քրիստոնյաների հարցով կապի խմբի նախագահ Բրունո Ռետայոյի գլխավորած պատվիրակությանը։

Ողջունելով հյուրերին՝ Նորին Սրբությունն ընդգծեց, որ պատվիրակաության այցը Հայաստան և Մայր Աթոռ Սուրբ Էջմիածին լավագույն վկայությունն է հայ-ֆրանսիական բարեկամության։ Վեհափառ Հայրապետն իր երխատագիտությունը հայտնեց Ֆրանսիայի Սենատին Հայոց Ցեղասպանության Ճանաչման, դատապարտման, ինչպես նաև Արցախի անկախության մասին բանաձնի ընդունման համար։


Անդրադառնալով տարածաշրջանում առկա դժվարին իրավիձակին՝ Հայոց Հովվապետը մտահոգությամբ անդրադարձավ արցախահայության և Հայաստանի ինքնիշխան տարածքների նկատմամբ Ադրբեջանի կողմից շարունակվող ոտնձգություններին։ Այս առնչությամբ Նորին Սրբությունը կարևոր նկատեց միջազգային հանրության հետևողական ջանքերի գործադրումն Ադրբեջանի որդեգրած ծավալապաշտական քաղաքականությունը կանխելու հարցում։

Ամենայն Հայոց Կաթողիկոսը նաև իր գնահատանքը հայտնեց Ֆրանսիայի իշխանություններին արցախյան 44-օրյա պատերազմի ընթացքում ու հետպատերազմյա շրջանում Հայաստանին և հայ ժողովրդին ցուցաբերած աջակցության և զորակցության համար։

Իր հերթին Ֆրանսիայի Մենատի պատվիրակության ղեկավար Բրունո Ռետայոն ընդգծեց, որ ջանքեր կգործադրի միջազգային ատյաններում բարձրաձայնելու արցախահայության ազատ ու անկախ ապրելու իրավունքի պահանջը։ Այս առիթով պատվիրակության ղեկավարը տեղեկացրեց Հայոց Հայրապետին, որ Ֆրանսիայի Սենատում ստեղծվել է Արցախի հարցով հանձնախումբ, որի նպատակն է աջակցել ու զորակցել արցախահայությանը։

Զրույցի ընթացքում անդրադարձ կատարվեց նաև գերիների վերադարձման, Լաչինի միջանցքի արգելափակման, Ադրբեջանի վերահսկողության տակ անցած հայկական հոգևոր և մշակութային ժառանգության պահպանման խնդիրներին։

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER - RED SUNDAY

April 30 this year is the fourth Sunday of Easter, also popularly called Red Sunday. The third Sunday which fell on April 23 as the Sunday of the World Church was popularly called Green Sunday. Our Church has given these popular colorful names, because we are reminded that through Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross and his resurrection, we are given new life, just as in the spring new growth in colors of green leaves and red tulips and poppies are signs of a newness of life.

The color red is associated with confronting struggle. For example:

- a red cloth held up to a bull during a bullfight invites the bull to combat the man holding it.
- Our people have named St. Vartan as "garmir Vartan" to indicate that he shed his red blood for the defense of his country's freedom to worship Christ.
- Christendom depicted the risen Christ in many icons clothed in red and holding a red flag with the sign of the cross on it. The red color reminds us of the blood of Christ shed on the Cross. As Christ's sacrifice resulted in victory, our own sacrifices in this world to overcome sin or evil will result in ultimate victory in Christ.

This leads us to acknowledge the fact that life is a struggle, a constant battle to choose between good and evil, to strive to live honestly, even if it leads one to lose materially, to stand up for justice for all, and above all to embrace the hard work of loving all, despite our differences.

The community of Christian believers, the Church, gives us the opportunity to look at the risen Christ who overcame all human weaknesses and healed the fallen human nature. We have all inherited that "mutated spiritual gene" which we name as the original sin of Adam and Eve. Through his total and unconditional reliance on the love of God the Father, Jesus victoriously broke the chains which bind our wounded humanity and he gave us the hope of living in everlasting joy with the Holy Trinity in heaven when he comes again. Until then, we are on a pilgrim journey. We face many challenges, temptations, and struggles in life.

Let us always turn to the victorious risen Christ who invites us to endure the temptations through God's help and join the victorious band of his faithful followers, whom we call saints.

Here is a Resurrection hymn that is sung in our Churches which reminds us of the risen Christ and simultaneously leads us to seek his mercy.



Meet Our Visiting Celebrant;

REV. FR. HOVEL OHANYAN

Rev. Fr. Hovel Ohanyan (birth name: Artak) was born on May 28, 1978, in the city of Ashtarak in the Republic of Armenia. He received his primary education at the local "Norayr Sisakyan" secondary school No. 5. From 1996 - 1998, he served in the RA Armed Forces in the north-eastern border zone.

In 1999, he was admitted to the Gevorkian Theological Seminary, and in 2005, he completed his six-year studies at the Seminary, after which, by the order of the Catholicos of All Armenians, he was appointed to serve as superintendent at the Seminary.

In 2005, by the order of the Catholicos, he was appointed as an executive secretary in the "Foreign Language Press" department of the Information Services of the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin.

In 2006, he defended his thesis entitled "Semantic Classification of Religious-Ecclesiastical Vocabulary (Names of Church Books)" with an "excellent" mark.

On the feast of St. Stephen, the Protomartyr in 2004, he was ordained as a deacon by Bishop Yezras Nersisyan, Primate of the Armenian Diocese of New Nakhichevan, and Russia. On April 15, 2007, New Sunday, he was ordained as a married priest by Archbishop Hovnan Derderian, Primate of the Western Diocese, and on February 24, 2008, he was awarded a "Letter of Blessing and Appreciation" and permission to use a pectoral cross. In 2017, on the occasion of the 10th anniversary of his priestly ordination, he was awarded a "Letter of Blessing and Appreciation" by the Primate. On July 23, 2021, he was awarded a Letter of "Patriarchal Blessing and Appreciation" and the right of wearing the priestly pectoral cross by the Catholicos. On February 22, 2022, on the occasion of the feast of St. Ghevond the Priest and His Companions, the Catholicos granted him the right of wearing a "Flowered Mantle".

In 2007, by the order of the Catholicos of All Armenians, he was called into service in the Western Diocese. He served the the communities of Santa Clarita, Palm Springs, the two newly formed communities of Ventura County and Santa Barbara, and lastly as the pastor of St. Vartan Armenian Apostolic Church in Oakland.

In 2012, presented the activities of the women's unions of the Diocese at the priests' meeting convened on the occasion of the feast of St. Ghevond the Priest and His Companions in the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin.

From 2008-2009, he continued his theological studies at Saint John's Catholic Seminary in Camarillo.

From 2010-2014, he continued his theological studies at the Patriarch Athenagoras Orthodox Institute, GTU (Graduate Theological Union), UC Berkeley. In 2014, he defended his theological thesis entitled "Water as a Symbol of Spiritual Rebirth in the Armenian Apostolic Orthodox Holy Church" and was awarded the title of Master of Theology.

From 2014-2016, he was a member of the Board of Trustees of the Patriarch Athenagoras Orthodox Institute. In 2015, with the blessing of the Primate, he published his theological thesis in a separate book.

In 2018, he participated in the "Priests' Training" courses in the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin.

In 2019, he translated into Modern Armenian language, edited, and published the book of Archbishop Khoren Ashigian, 19th century Armenian Patriarch of Constantinople, entitled "Clergymen's Mode of Life", which was republished in 2022.

In 2022, he translated into Modern Armenian language, edited, and published the work of Bishop Melchizedek Muradiants, 19th century famous Armenian nationalecclesiastical figure, entitled "Pastoral Theology", and was awarded a "Letter of Blessing" by the Catholicos.


Der Hovel has organised pilgrimages to the motherland, Artsakh and the Holy Land.

In 2020, after completing his service in the Western Diocese of the Armenian Church of the USA, he returned to the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin and was appointed to serve at the Gevorkian Theological Seminary as the deputy dean in the field of education.

He was an instructor of "Pastoral Theology" at the Gevorkian Theological Seminary.

Rev. Fr. Hovel Ohanyan married Anahit Ohanyan in 2005 and the couple is blessed with four children – Vazgen, Nare, Nazeni and Nrane.

"The mission of the Armenian Apostolic Orthodox Church is to preach the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and to proclaim its message of salvation. This mission is realized through worship, education, witness, service, and the common life in Christ as expressed in the distinctive faith-experience of the Armenian people."

Further, dues-paying members are eligible to participate in the governance of our parish by voting at the Parish Assembly and may run for office in any of the executive bodies of the various organizations of the parish, including the Parish Council.

The St. Leon Parish Assembly has designated the following amounts as the required minimum dues for St. Leon Parish Membership. Please consider becoming a dues-paying member & contribute as generously as the Lord leads you.

~There are no wedding sacraments permitted on the five major feast days in the Armenian Church which are:

Armenian Christmas – January 6, 2024 Easter –March 31, 2024 Transfiguration – July 16, 2023 Assumption of the Virgin Mary – August 13, 2023 Exaltation of the Holy Cross – September 17, 2023
