





Wedding in Cana

The structure of John's Gospel 2:1-11, emphasizes Jesus' Divinity which is typical of a miracle story. It establishes the setting to reveal the presence of God. The wine runs out and Jesus changes the water into wine which becomes his first public act as the inaugural sign of God's presence in the world through the Lord. When Jesus enters the temple courtyard, the worship, he sees the place filled with merchants selling sacrificial animals and exchanging foreign currencies. Angrily, Jesus flips their tables in which He quotes the Prophet Isaiah, "My house should be called a place of Worship, but you have turned it into a place where robbers hide." Isaiah 21:13. Jesus says, he will destroy the temple and raise it up in three days, but he is speaking about his bodily resurrection. The Pharisees could not understand the depth of Jesus' teachings.
